

Kitchen remodel costs & considerations

The checklist will save you time and money. Why? There are a ton of small things that you have to keep in mind. Your brain is for solving problems, not storing data. Take a hint from the airline pilots. They do the same thing several times a day for years, and they still use a checklist for everything.

Budget	Buying and Ordering
How much can you afford? \$	Select appliances. How much space for each appliance? Research ratings.
Add 30%, can you still afford it? \$	Look at cabinet styles and get preliminary estimates.
What can you reuse?	Browse countertop options.
What can you resell? Almost everything can be sold	Get ideas for any large features you want for your kitchen.
What don't you need? 6 burners on a stove are almost never used at once	Consider hiring a professional kitchen designer.
	Begin designing the layout for the room.

	Begin ordering windows, doors, moldings, appliances, sink, flooring, etc.
	When ordering, ask about delivery times and installation costs.
	Set up a chronological spreadsheet. Expect it to slip.
	Agree on a payment plan, never pay more than 30% in advance.
	Sign contracts for cabinets, demolition, installation, and other work

Preparation

Prepare a description of your project and send the request for proposal to at least three general contractors. The prices can be wildly different, and you have to figure out whom you trust with your new kitchen.

Preparation	Demolition
Get a trash container.	Keep the kitchen functional as long as possible
Set up a temporary kitchen.	Top cabinets
Clean out the kitchen.	Countertops and sink
Wait for new cabinets and appliances.	Remove appliances
Get rid of old appliances and cabinets.	Base cabinets
Shut off electricity, then water.	Flooring
Clean the kitchen and trash area.	Walls where needed
Plan to keep the work areas clean daily.

Construction & cleanup

Now you are ready for the construction work to start. The details are all in place, the scope of the work, warranty, payment terms, and other items to make sure everything goes smoothly.

Plumbing & electricity	Installation & decoration
Install the sink, faucets, disposal, and connect water. Test for leaks.	Install wall cabinets
Electricity main lines to outlet and appliance locations	Install base cabinets
Relocate gas when needed	Built-in appliances, need to be ready when cabinets are installed
Relocate exhaust hood vent	Install countertops
Set HVAC locations	Install drawers and doors
	Install backsplash
Walls & floors	Install cabinet end panels and appliance panel covers
Drywall	Install lighting fixtures to the ceiling, wall, or under cabinets
Painting the walls	Install window treatments
Install flooring	Drywall installation materials \$
	Clean and polish everything
